Thomas Watral's Bay Report

- > Tuesday, October 28: "Across the Bay in the north end, I've seen a range on minnows and Subiki Rigs; picking up crappie with spoons in silver/orange or silver/blue. Crappie are biting grubs; set the bobber at five feet. Perch biting spoons and worms."
- > Saturday, November 1: "I've been out in the Bay and on the well as the new fishing areas on the old GAF. I'm leaving these areas with a few more of the glow in the dark that glow in the dark. Customers are telling me they are catching crappie from marina walls. Crappie jigs tipped with minnow heads are working from Mill Creek to the mall; one gentleman stopped in from Mill Creek. I still have lots of tackle in Erie."

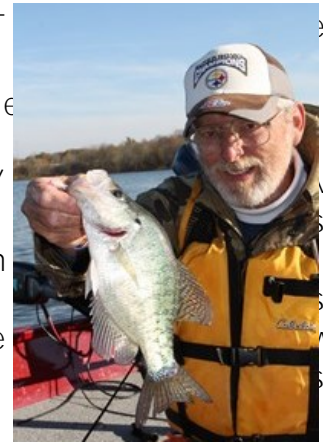
Lake Wilhelm

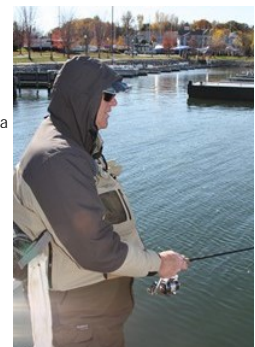

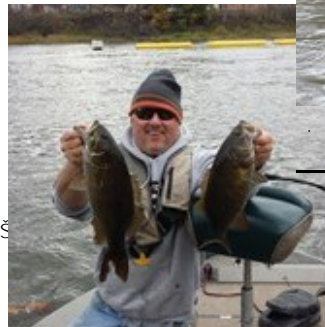
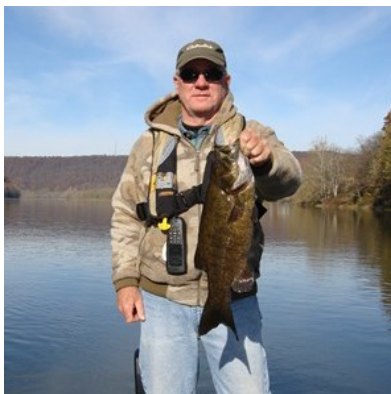

Gamma Fishing Tip



November is blade bait time. In cases where those compact teardrop shaped thin blades are used on the bottom front portion of the blade bait. In the late fall and early winter, fish are feeding on the bottom either by casting and retrieve or by working fish like a jig; or by working fish like a jig down like a worm. When fished properly, blade baits can be used in deep water for black bass, walleye, bluegills and even musky. And don't forget, blades vertically can quickly twist and turn. A simple step: tying a quality swivel in line with the swivel, after a day of blade fishing, you'll find your line is still straight.

Because changing line often is necessary, that's a cost savings step. Gamma Edge fluorocarbon works great when you fishing straight down, it's easy to get a full hookset. (Darl Black)
